



***WHAT TO EXPECT
WITH FASENRA®
SELF-ADMINISTRATION
TRAINING***

**You and your doctor have decided that you can self-administer FASENRA®:
Now what?**

Through the Connect360° Patient Support Program, you or your caregiver will receive training on how to administer FASENRA®. Training is available either virtually, or in-person at a Connect360° Program, or at your healthcare provider's office.

What's involved in training?



1. Education

- You or your caregiver will observe a healthcare provider administer your first injection.
- Educational materials will be provided to you to review.
- You'll have the opportunity to ask questions about your medication and injections.



2. Demonstration

- You or your caregiver will administer your second injection, with the support and supervision of a healthcare provider.
- Don't forget to bring along any questions you may have while reviewing the educational materials provided to you in your previous appointment.



3. Verification

- You or your caregiver will administer your third injection, and your healthcare provider will then confirm that you can properly administer FASENRA®.
- Additional educational materials will be provided to you to review, including the FASENRA® Patient Resource Hub.



4. Coordination

- Someone from the Connect360° Program will reach out to coordinate drug pickup and/or home delivery of your FASENRA® doses.
- Doses can be shipped to a location of your choosing (home, work, etc.).



5. Welcome Kit

- You'll receive a Welcome Kit with your first FASENRA® home delivery, which includes information and supplies needed to administer FASENRA®.



6. Ongoing Support

- You'll continue to receive reminders and regular communications from the Connect360° Program, before and after each injection.
- Your healthcare provider will also receive updates after each of your injections.
- You'll also be trained on the proper storage and handling of your FASENRA®.
